

## Rules and Policies for Attending an Event at Happy Dogs Training Center

**REFUND POLICY:** Registration fees are transferrable (with notice to Happy Dogs Training Center).  
Registration fees are not refundable.

**DECLARATION OF PET'S HEALTH:** I acknowledge that my dog is in good health, injury free, and that participation in this event does not contradict any recommendations or guidelines established for my dog by a veterinary professional. My pet is free of internal/external parasites, any communicable diseases, and has received appropriate vaccinations (titers are acceptable) including Bordetella.

**ACCEPTANCE OF LIABILITY, RISK, AND INDEMNIFICATION:** I acknowledge that I am responsible for the successful training, control and conduct of my dog at all times during training sessions and while on the premises of Happy Dogs Training Center. I am solely liable for any injury to persons or damage to property caused or incurred by me or my dog. I hold harmless and indemnify and defend persons presenting seminars and workshops at Happy Dogs Training Center, LLC, Todd McGahey, Lou Ann McGahey and Happy Dogs Training Center, LLC from all injuries or damage caused or incurred by me or my dog whatsoever.

### HOUSEKEEPING RULES

- Dogs should be comfortable working in a new environment and around unfamiliar dogs and people.
- Dogs must be crated unless working in ring; or preparing to enter ring because they are next team to work. Crates should be secured on all sides and the top.
- Dog nails must be kept trimmed to avoid damage to mats and possible injury to dog.
- No overnight RV parking or tent camping on Happy Dogs Training Center property without advance approval.
- Participants are required to provide a protective floor covering large enough to fit under their crate **and** chair. Chairs may shift during the day. Participants should make sure all four legs of their chair remain on the floor covering at all times.
- Participants must clean up after their dogs and dispose of waste. The designated potty area is located at the back corner of the parking lot. Discard waste outside in the waste receptacle in the potty area. Do not use the trash cans in the building for waste or materials used to clean.
- Do not allow your dog to urinate on the lawn directly in front of the building, the flowerpots, or the waste receptacle. If an accident occurs, please clean it up.
