

Rules and Policies for Attending an Event at Happy Dogs Training Center

REFUND POLICY: Registration fees are transferrable (with notice to Happy Dogs Training Center). Registration fees are not refundable after the date specified on the registration form.

DECLARATION OF PET'S HEALTH: I acknowledge that my dog is in good health, injury free, and that participation in this event does not contradict any recommendations or guidelines established for my dog by a veterinary professional. My pet is free of internal/external parasites, any communicable diseases, and has received appropriate vaccinations (titers are acceptable) including Bordetella.

ACCEPTANCE OF LIABILITY, RISK, AND INDEMNIFICATION: I acknowledge that I am responsible for the successful training, control and conduct of my dog during training sessions and while on the premises of Happy Dogs Training Center. I am solely liable for any injury to persons or damage to property caused or incurred by me or my dog. I hold harmless and indemnify and defend persons presenting seminars and workshops at Happy Dogs Training Center, LLC, Todd McGahey, Lou Ann McGahey and Happy Dogs Training Center, LLC from all injuries or damage caused or incurred by me or my dog whatsoever.

GENERAL RULES

- Your dog should be comfortable working in an unfamiliar environment and around unfamiliar dogs and people.
- Your dog should remain crated unless you are working in the ring or are in line to enter the ring. Crates should be secured on all sides and the top.
- Do not assume that every dog wants to visit with your dog. Please prevent your dog from visiting with other dogs or approaching a crated dog.
- Trim your dog's nails prior to the event to avoid damage to mats and injury to your dog.
- Please bring a rug or mat to put under your crate and chair. Make sure your crate and all four legs of your chair remain on the floor covering.
- There is a designated potty area located at the back corner of the parking lot. Please clean up after your dog in the building or anywhere outside. All waste should be deposited **outside** in the waste receptacle located near the designated potty area.
- Do not allow your dog to pee on the building, in the grass directly in front of the building, or on the flowerpots or waste receptacle. If an accident occurs, please clean and rinse the area to discourage other dogs from peeing in the same area.
- No overnight RV parking or tent camping on Happy Dogs Training Center property without advance approval.
